Accommodation



Resthaven has been established to provide Christian based self-catering accommodation for family holidays and also as a retreat for those needing to get away for a while.

The three bedroom house has its own driveway and garden and is situated in a quiet cul-de-sac. It is a short 6 minute walk to Porthleven harbour, beach, and all amenities.

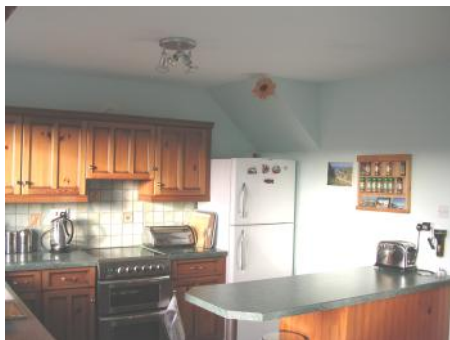
The home has been tastefully decorated and furnished throughout, with every comfort and convenience in mind.

The **Lounge** has 2 large comfy sofas and an occasional table.

There is a cosy log burning stove for use during the winter months.

The room is fully equipped with wide screen satellite TV, Video/DVD and HiFi.

There is a small games cupboard, a collection of DVDs/Video tapes, CDs and various books for study, local interest and family entertainment.



The **Kitchen/Dining** room is fully equipped with all you need for a family stay, whether eating in or out.

A patio door opens onto steps leading down to a private and enclosed garden.

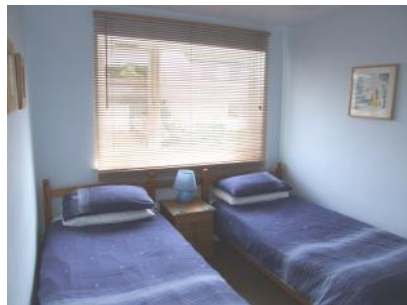
The **garden** is terraced and a timber decked area provides a place to relax or eat outside.

A table and garden furniture is provided.



Bedroom 1 has a double bed, solid pine wardrobe, chest of drawers and bedside cabinets.

The room overlooks the back garden and provides countryside views and sea glimpses.

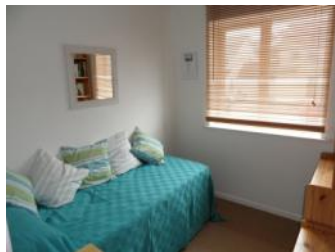


Bedroom 2 has twin beds with solid pine combination wardrobe and bedside cabinet, plus additional drawer space.

The room overlooks the front garden.

Bedroom 3 has a single bed plus solid pine chest and drawers.

There is a collection of books from light reading to more serious study.



The **Bathroom** includes an electric shower over a large bath, shaver point, bathroom heater, tall cupboard and towel rail.

An automatic washing machine is in the kitchen, with clothes airers, outside rotary washing line, iron and ironing board all to hand should you need to do any laundry.

A travel cot and high chair are available on request for the very young.

The landing has a view across open countryside as seen in the picture, and it is surprising how often you stop there just to enjoy the view !



The house benefits from double glazing and thermal insulation and is kept warm during the winter by Night Storage heating. If desired auxiliary heating is also available.

Please note that Resthaven is a completely non-smoking environment and no pets.

Porthleven



Porthleven is located in an area of outstanding natural beauty between the UK's most westerly site, Land's End, and its most southern, Lizard Point. It is the most southerly port in mainland Britain and has long been a balanced blend of working Cornish fishing port and holiday resort.

Many who come say how much they really appreciate the charm of this harbour village, with its fishing boats, typical Cornish narrow streets and distinctive clock tower. A walk up the hills surrounding the village will reward you with panoramic sea, harbour and landscape views.

The beach at Porthleven is sand and shingle with plenty of rock-pools. At low tide the beach extends down to other interesting local sites such as Loe Bar. Also nearby are dramatic coastal scenery, golden beaches, secluded coves and luscious green pastures.

Fishing or pleasure boat trips are available from the harbour office.

Although compact, Porthleven offers all the amenities that are needed for an easy and restful self-catering holiday, including supermarket, chemist, Post Office, cafes, restaurants and pubs to suit all tastes and pockets. There are also various gift, craft, clothes shops and art galleries.

The town of Helston is only minutes away by car and has large supermarkets such as Sainsbury and Tesco, plus a wide range of shops. It also has Flambards which is one of Cornwall's premier theme parks.

Surf and sand beaches such as Praa Sands and beautiful quiet coves are within easy driving distance. In fact Porthleven offers an excellent base for exploring Cornwall as there are many Gardens, tourist attractions, historic sites and parks all within a short drive.

Porthleven is on the South West Coastal path and we can personally recommend the spectacular if sometimes challenging walks that can be taken from there. A lot of the land and beaches in the area are National Trust owned to protect the natural beauty of the region.

Finally for those seeking solitude and time to reflect, there is nothing like being near the sea, and it is always easy to find a quiet scenic spot to enjoy the beauty of God's Creation whether alone or with others.

Prices and Availability

Resthaven is generally available all year. See website or call for the latest availability.

Prices range from £180 to £540 per week.

Electricity and bed linen are included, but not towels.

Discounts are available for Church leaders, those in recognised ministries, and anyone who has a genuine need for respite and to seek the Lord.
